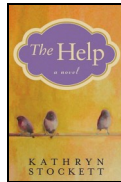
### APRIL BOOK CLUB

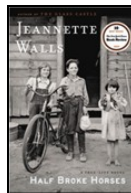


### MAY BOOK CLUB
