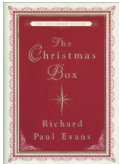

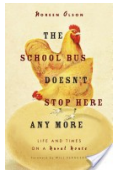

The School Bus Doesn't Stop Here Anymore by Noreen Olson

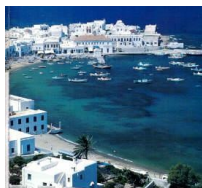
