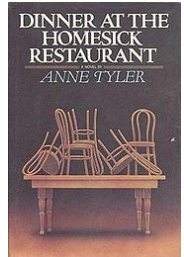

EMR COURSE AVAILABLE IN CARSTAIRS

EMR course is 12 weeks in duration and a flexible schedule will be set to meet students and instructor requirements. The students will receive 6 credits upon successful completion of the course.
