HELP WANTED

Part-time Coordinator wanted for the Engagement Site in Cremona.

Cremona CES is owned and operated by the community and serves as a center to support the delivery of a wide range of services including learning, healthy living, arts and culture, and business support. These services are accessible to a wide range of community members. The site designs programs and services that are of specific interest to the community. Activities are guided by a Board of Directors, made up of representatives from our community institutions and organizations as well as local individuals with an interest in lifelong learning. Our focus is mainly continuing education for the community.

HOURS AND SALARY Part-time, 10 - 12 hours/week September-June \$17-\$20/hour based on experience

In collaboration with the Site Coordinator you will be working in a job sharing capacity to address the everyday operation of the Engagement Site. Together you will be responsible for:

- ◆ Identifying and developing program options to meet the needs of the community.
- ◆ Determining the cost recovery for each program.
- ◆ Tracking the programs, participant demographics and outcomes.
- ◆ Attending Advisory Council meetings and providing a written report to the Board once a month.
- ◆ Searching out and applying for grants to maintain a sustainable, cost recovery site.
- ◆ Advertising and promotion of the site and the programs.
- ◆ Working with Campus Alberta Central to promote and provide support for participants taking online college credit courses.
- ◆ Providing some technical support to presenters using our equipment.

Daytime and evening programming hours and the occasional Saturday hours required.

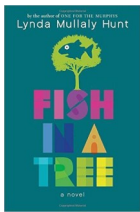

May 9th – FISH IN A TREE by Lynda Mullaly Hunt



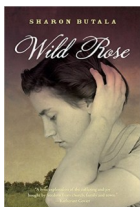
