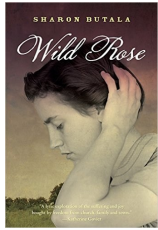

HEALTH CARE AIDE CERTIFICATE PROGRAM ADULT LEARNERS

The Health Care Aide Certificate Program provides students with the skills required to provide personal care for patients in long-term care, acute care, and community/home care settings. Health Care Aides assist patients with mobility and feeding needs, communication, medication delivery, and generally create a comfortable environment for them.

With one 5-day and one 4-week practicum, you will gain hands-on, practical experience in providing a high level of front-line care to clients in need of assistance. Full-time, blended (combines online learning with face-to-face lab instruction)
